Fund raising for Ukrainian orphans

Rotary International is beyond politics but always present when help is needed for the most vulnerable. Today in Europe it is Ukraine and those Ukrainian children who have lost their parents in war. Orphanages are overcrowded. There are shortages in food and medicines.

Children are not at fault, children do not declare war, children who have lost their parents, their homes and their childhood are the greatest victims of this war. We cannot stop the war but we can support these children with our kindness and affection.

Latvia is the first nation in Europe to call out to the world's most compassionate people, to support fund raising for the children in Ukraine.



The highlight of this fundraising effort will be a large scale Charity Concert "Children of War" taking place on 6 July 2015 in Latvia, City of Jūrmala (20 km from Riga) Dzintari Concert Hall.

Initiated & Organized by Rotary in Latvia



The initiators and organisers of the Charity Concert are Rotary clubs in Latvia from District 2410 in cooperation with individual volunteers of various professions.

Rotary stands for peace, compassion and charity and with the Rotary logo on the stage we can say loudly – Rotary stands for the future of Ukrainian children regardless of their ethnicity.

The patroness of the concert is Ms. Ināra Mūrniece, the Speaker of the Latvian Parliament (Saeima). The concert will be attended by the Ukrainian government and state representatives from neighbouring countries.

Donations for rehabilitation

The collected donations, including the income from the concert, and charitable contributions raised during the broadcast on the National TV and WEB, will be used to bring dozens of Ukrainian children who have lost a parent to war and now live in the orphanages to several of Latvia's sanatoriums in September-November where they will brighten up their spirits and regain their well-being over the course of a few weeks.

Rehabilitation and transportation per child is estimated at 800 EUR.



Outstanding artists & performances

The stage will be taken by Latvia's brightest talents – celebrated opera diva **Inese Galante**, countertenor **Sergejs Jēgers**, world famous opera singer **Sonora Vaice**, musicians **Jānis Stībelis**, **Kārlis Lācis**, choir "Kamēr...", **Liepāja Symphony Orchestra**, **Riga Cathedral Girls' Choir** and a special guest from Ukraine - **Dmitro Popovs**.

All of the artists will perform with no reward other than to be part

of this inspiring and touching event.
